By being a user and accessing our website, you agree to the processing, collection, and gathering of your personal information according to this privacy policy.

Due to the nature of changing laws that vary from Country to Country, and state to state, it is possible that we may change this privacy policy from time to time by updating this page. We will continue to change our privacy policy from time to time. You are requested to visit this page periodically. By accessing our website and your use of our services you grant us your consent to process your information according to this policy.

SECTION 1 - WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

Personal Information You Provide to Us:

We may receive and store any information you submit to the website (or otherwise authorize us to obtain – such as, from (for example) your Facebook account). The types of personal information collected may include your full name, email address, gender, IP address, browser information, username, demographic information, and any other information necessary for us to provide better website user services.

Personal Information Collected Automatically:

We receive and store certain types of usage related information whenever you interact with the website. For example, GLOBAL FX ACADEMY, LLC (<https://globalfxtraining.com/>) may automatically receive and record information regarding your computer's IP address, cookies, browser information, Facebook user ID, Facebook Page fan status, and URLs accessed. Such information may be shared in the aggregate (non-personally identifiable) form with our partners.

SECTION 2 - WILL WE SHARE ANY OF THE PERSONAL INFORMATION IT RECEIVES?

The information we collect from our users is an integral part of the functionality of our business. We must clarify that we do not sell any of such collected information, neither do we share it (with the exception of sharing the information as described in this privacy policy

Website Service Partners: We may share the information with an applicable website service provider. The website service providers are our partners which may help us from time to time by maintaining our website properly.

Agents: From time to time, it is possible that we may hire some people to perform the task on our behalf, and to do that we may have to share the information that we are collecting with them. The persons who are completing and acting on our behalf are called agents and they are an integral part of

any working organization. You hereby consent to our sharing of personal information for the above purposes.

Business Transfers: It is possible that with the passage of time our business may expand or reduce. Keeping that in mind and according to the circumstances we may buy or sell assets. In these types of transactions, customer information is typically one of the business assets that are transferred. Moreover, if GLOBAL FX ACADEMY, LLC, or substantially all of its assets were acquired, or in the unlikely event that we go out of business or enter bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that are transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur and that any acquirer of our website may continue to use your personal information as outlined in this policy.

SECTION 3 - HOW DO WE USE THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT?

The information we collect may be used in the following ways:

- I. We may use this information to improve the quality and content of the website.
- II. We may use the information to make our services better, specifically our customer service.
- III. To ask for reviews, ratings, and comments regarding our services, content, and products.
- IV. We may use the information in follow up correspondence like email, phone, and live chat
- V. To send you additional information which is related to your product.
- VI. We may use the information to personalize your user/client experience and send you the most interesting information according to your content and product.
- VII. We may use this information in relation to marketing by sending our clients emails after they have signed up with us.

SECTION 4 - WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION CAN I ACCESS?

SECTION 5 - ACCOUNT RELATED INFORMATION

This information is more obvious and is collected when you join and use our services. This includes the information you provide us through the form you have filled, webpages you have visited, emails you have been sent, and other ways that you and we use to communicate with each other such as through customer service experience.

SECTION 6 - COOKIES AND DATA USAGE OF SERVICES

The website of the GLOBAL FX ACADEMY, LLC collects data through cookies. A cookie is a file containing an identifier that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. Cookies may be either “persistent” cookies or “session” cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed. Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

A cookie may also convey information to us about how you use the service (e.g., the pages you view, the web-links you click, how often you access the service, and other actions you take on the service), and allow us to track the usage of your account of our service over time. This only helps us to make your experience better and gives us insights on how to improve our service quality for the future. We may also collect log files information about your browser or mobile device each time you log in to access the service.

The information in the log file may include information such as your web request, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, the type of browser you use, information about your cell phone device, referring / exit pages and URLs, the number of clicks and how you communicate with the links on the service, domain addresses, pages viewed, and other such information. The information allows us for more accurate reporting and improvement of the service.

SECTION 7 – GOOGLE ANALYTICS AND DATA COLLECTION

Data analytics is the science of examining data and drawing conclusions about that information by applying algorithms to derive insights. Thus, in order to do that, we may also collect analytics data, or use third-party analytics tools, to help us measure traffic data and user’s trends for the services. Google Analytics is one such service that we used to collect information about users’ interaction with our website. This includes the stats like what pages you have visited, what websites you have visited prior to visiting our website, what browser and operating system you use. Through what network you use to connect with us and what is your IP address. The tools we use to place a cookie on your browser to identify you as a unique user when you visit us next time, each of such unique cookies cannot be used by any other service provider such as Google for Google Analytics.

The information collected through cookies may be transferred and stored on the servers which may be outside of the country in which you reside. We make it clear that this information is collected through automated algorithms and does not include your personal information. You can control by not sharing such information by third-party tools such as disconnect among others.

SECTION 8- DISCLOSURE REGARDING THIRD PARTIES DATA COLLECTION

We do not and will not sell information to others nor do we transfer your information with anyone unless we give you prior notice. We may share your information with third-party websites and service providers who help and aid us in making our business operational. These service providers may include but are not limited to hosting companies, database providers, security service providers, payment processors. The information will be shared only for the purpose of providing our services to you. Whenever we share information of any kind with any third-party site or service provider, that service provider and site is bound by a contract with us and is in charge of safeguarding your information.

SECTION 9 - LINKS BY THIRD PARTIES

The website may permit you to link to other websites or applications and doing so may result in storing certain data of users using third add-ons, software and other services made by other companies the privacy of which is not under our control and such links do not constitute an endorsement by GLOBAL FX ACADEMY, LLC of those other applications/websites or the services offered through them. The privacy and security practices of such third party applications/websites linked to the websites or applications are not covered by this Privacy Policy, and GLOBAL FX ACADEMY, LLC is not responsible for the privacy or security practices or the content of such websites.

SECTION 10 - CALIFORNIA ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT (CalOPPA)
